Smoking Shelter

Public space is increasingly controlled and placed under surveillance as well as being highly regulated. One of the most recent developments is the German non-smokers law that severely limits smoking in public. Grubinger designs a smoking shelter to be situated in the beautiful landscape of the Graftschaft and actively used by cyclists or hikers. It contains a grid metal floor including a case for ashes and fags. A black bar at eye level helps preserve the smokers' anonymity and protects the users from the outlook.
